| Latitude            | The distance between the equator and a point north or south of the Earth's surface.                                            |
| Longitude           | distance on the earth's surface east or west of an imaginary line on the globe that goes from the north pole to the south pole |
| Climate zone        | An area with a distinct climate (weather)                                                                                      |
| Temperature         | The degree of heat or cold of an object or an environment.                                                                     |
| Tropic of Cancer    | An imaginary latitude line located above the equator that runs across the globe at about 23 degrees north.                     |
| Tropic of Capricorn | South of the Equator and marks the most southerly latitude at which the sun can appear directly overhead at noon.              |
| Tropical            | Very hot or humid.                                                                                                             |
| Biome               | A major type of global region.                                                                                                 |
| Deforestation       | The removal of trees or forest forms.                                                                                          |
| Farming             | The business or practice of raising crops and livestock.                                                                       |
| Harvest             | The gathering of crops.                                                                                                        |
| Fair Trade          | A system that makes sure a product, usually from a poorer country, gets a fair price for the product they are selling.         |
| Crop                | Plants grown on a farm.                                                                                                        |
