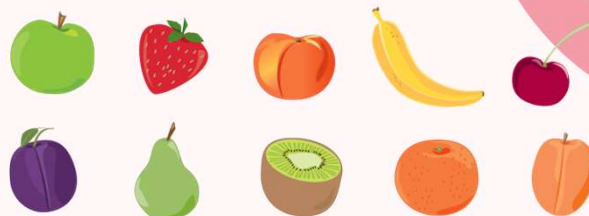
The 'r' sound in French is guttural - from the back of the throat, like in the words 'fraise'  and 'prune' .
